

### A BRIEF HISTORY

**2024-** Clemson won the Beach Bracket with a 75-67 victory over Penn State in the Championship game. Ian Schieffelin won MVP of the tournament. Schieffelin grabbed 26 rebounds during in the Tigers two wins in Daytona Beach. Radford defeated Purdue Fort Wayne 69-56 in the Final of the Ocean Bracket. The Highlanders' defense shined in the Ocean Center allowing 52 points per game.

**2023-** Florida State defeated Colorado 77-71 in Overtime in a thrilling Beach Bracket Final. Jamir Watkins took home MVP honors. Watkins scored 18 points and brought down 11 rebounds during the Championship Game. Stetson defeated Central Michigan 71-61 in the Ocean Bracket Final with Jalen Blackmon winning MVP. The Hatters cruised to a championship winning by an average of 14 points.

**2022-** UAB cruised to victory in the Beach Bracket, winning their three games by an average of 20 points. The Blazers defeated Georgia 87-73 in the final with Jordan Walker taking home MVP honors after a strong tournament. Bucknell defeated Austin Peay 79-65 in the Ocean Bracket final. Xander Rice led the way for the Bison scoring 20 points and grabbing 5 rebounds in the final.

**2021**- Coming off a canceled 2020 saw a different format for the Sunshine Slam. Instead of one round-robin event, two separate tournaments were held simultaneously at the Ocean Center in Daytona Beach. In the Beach Bracket, Utah took home the title, beating Boston College (68-61) and then Tulsa (72-58) behind the effort of tournament MVP Branden Carlson. In the Ocean Bracket, Air Force took down Holy Cross (72-53) and Bethune-Cookman (73-65) to earn the title. Air Force's A.J. Walker was named MVP of that bracket.

2020- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the event was canceled.

**2019-** Delaware went 3-0 in the inaugural Sunshine Slam, winning its three games by an average of 5.7 ppg. The Blue Hens' Nate Darling averaged 25.7 ppg, which included a 37-point outburst against UTSA, to capture MVP honors.
